# Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Tax Credit: 2024 Tax Year Overview

#### What is it?

Employers who provide CTR incentives and/or benefits to their employees can receive a tax credit against their Business and Occupation (B&O) Tax or Public Utility Tax (PUT) liability. An employer does not need to be CTR affected to be eligible for this benefit.

## An employer is eligible if they:

- Pay B&O or PUT in Washington State
- Incur expenses through promoting or providing rideshare, carshare, public transit, or nonmotorized commuting services
  - o i.e. providing ORCA cards for your employees, subsidizing vanpool costs, paying for employee bike repairs, etc.
- Apply for the credit by January 31, 2025

#### **Credit Amounts**

- Claim up to **50% of qualifying expenses** (maximum \$60 per employee).
- No employer may receive more than \$100,000 of credit per fiscal year.

## **Application Details**

- Applications are open from January 1–31, 2025.
- Submit through the WA Department of Revenue's portal: CTR Tax Credit Portal.

### Steps to Apply

- 1. Collect Data You will likely need to locate receipts and invoices to determine the following:
  - a. Number of employees receiving the CTR incentive.
  - b. Amount spent per employee on eligible incentives.
  - Contact your transit pass provider for information about invoicing or your annual transit pass costs if you have trouble finding this information.
  - You may need to calculate per employee costs yourself by dividing the total cost by the total number of employees receiving the benefit.
    - If utilizing ORCA passport or ORCA business programs, you can calculate this cost by combining all annual fees/costs excluding the card fee and dividing by the total number of employees receiving the benefit.
  - If you find you are spending more than \$120/employee/year on CTR incentives, you can stop calculating costs and enter \$120, the maximum amount you can claim per employee.

#### 2. Submit Information:

a. Log in to the Department of Revenue portal.

- b. To find the CTR tax credit application, click: More Excise Tax Options > Manage/Apply for a Tax Credit > Add CTR Application
- c. Fill out the necessary fields with the data requested and submit your application.
