

Connection: Commuters share a ride to connect with another form of public transportation (train, bus or ferry), the last or first mile link.




Service Change



Switch Your Trips WA is for commutes, errands, and social outings. That means carpooling to work, taking the bus to the grocery store, bicycling to a friend's house, etc. all will help you qualify for the prize drawing and have a chance to win \$1,500, an electric bike, or one of many other great prizes.








Rider Demand

•BellHop Demand is off the charts. We are currently receiving more than double the ride requests that we can complete. As a community and service, we need to address this ASAP. We are planning another fleet and charging infrastructure expansion but outside investment will be needed. We have recently submitted a grant request to PSE for the needed expansion.
